

Dhaka CCI and Selenge Province CCI Named Best Local Chambers

Two local chambers – one from Bangladesh and the other from Mongolia – received this year’s 4th Local Chamber Awards during the Gala Dinner held on July 6 in conjunction with the 24th CACCI Conference in Colombo, Sri Lanka.

The proud winners of the prestigious Awards were the **Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (DCCI)** from Bangladesh which won under the Big Chamber category, and the **Selenge Province Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SPCCI)** from Mongolia which was proclaimed the winner under the Small Chamber category.

The two chambers were cited for their outstanding achievements in promoting the industrial, commercial

DCCI has current a membership of about 4,000 who represent about 37 types of businesses. About 70% of its members are SMEs, while 30% are large enterprises.

established in 2002 for the purpose of implementing the activities of the Mongolian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MNCCI). Their main goals are to develop the private sector, protect the rights and common interests of member and nonmember companies and support their business activities. ■
