Tony Park



Mr. Tony Park is a business icon in Tasmania. He owns several businesses, including a vineyard, a printing company and a travel agency. He is a director of the Tasmanian Chamber of Commerce and Industry and was appointed to the board of the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry in March 2007. He is a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Company Directors and the Australian Institute of Management, and a former world vice-president of the Junior Chamber International and national president of Jaycees Australia. He is a director of the Tourism Council of Tasmania and of the Asia Pacific Senate for the Junior Chamber International.

Mr. Junichi Murata is Chairman of Murata Machinery Ltd., which is engaged in the manufacture of

textile machinery, machine tools, automated systems, clean systems, and communication equipment. He also served as Chairman of Kyoto Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Vice Chairman of the Japan Chamber of Commerce and Industry (JCCI). He currently serves as Special Advisor of JCCI.

Jemal Inaishvili
