The CACCI Council has conferred the title of “President Emeritus” to three former CACCI Presidents in recognition of their continued active participation in the projects, programs and annual gatherings of the Confederation.

The three former CACCI heads given the distinct honor are Mr. Kenneth Court from Australia, Secretary Alfonso T. Yuchengco from the Philippines, and Mr. Krishan Kumar Modi from India.

Mr. Court served as CACCI President in 1998-1990, Secretary Yuchengco in 1995-1996, and Mr. Modi in 2002-2006.

Mr. Court, Amb. Yuchengco, and Mr. Modi have remained active in CACCI and continue to take important roles in setting the direction of the Confederation even after their tenure as President ended. Furthermore, they have expressed interest and willingness to continue their involvement in CACCI meetings and programs in the years ahead.
