

CACCI Delegates Visit Key Business Associations in Taiwan

Overseas participants of the CACCI Summit Meeting held on October 13-14, 2011 in Taipei were given the opportunity to visit two of the most important business associations in Taiwan, namely, the Chinese National Federation of Industries (CNFI) and The General Chamber of Commerce of the Republic of China.

The CACCI delegation, which was headed by CACCI President Amb. Benedicto Yujico and composed mostly of business leaders and chamber executives from some 16 Asian countries, met with the key officers and members of the two business associations and had a dialogue with them on matters of mutual interest.

The CACCI visitors were received at the headquarters of The Chinese National Federation of Industries (CNFI) by its top officers and staff members led by CNFI Chairman Mr. Preston Chen, who gave them a briefing on the functions and activities of CNFI.

The CACCI delegation learned some important information about CNFI, including the following:

1. The Chinese National Federation of Industries (CNFI) is a nonprofit organization consisting of 152 member associations in their respective fields of manufacturing industry in the Republic of China. With each member association representing its specific line of manufacturing, all the associations together stand for more than 100,000 industrial companies in this country.

2. CNFI member companies account for 30% of Taiwan's GDP in terms of their product value

amounting to NT\$114.36 billion, and employ 3.5 million workers, accounting for 36% of the working population. The CNFI is considered to be the largest and most influential industrial federation in Taiwan.

The General Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the R.O.C.



The CACCI delegation was welcomed to the General Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the ROC (ROCCOC) office by its Chairman Mr. Chang Pen-Tsao. Through an

interpreter, Mr. Tsao gave the visitors a brief background on the ROCCOC.

The delegates learned that the ROCCOC is a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting the common interests of private sector business community in Taiwan, and to elevate the domestic commercial environment. It strives to foster prosperity through promoting foreign trade, enhancing economic growth and cooperative relations among the various parts of the business community.

The CACCI delegation had a lively and highly informative dialogue with Chairman Chang on the activities and operations of ROCCOC.
